2019-2020 Service Accomplishments:



A summary of 2019-2020 service accomplishments:

6,000 hours of service for AmeriCorps Serve Kentucky completed by our Urban Conservation Corps members;

1,451 additional hours of community service for AmeriCorps

90 youth provided with digital literacy training
8 GEDs obtained

9 service projects completed

Walnut St. Baptist Church Community Center: 11-20 staff and students renovated 13 rooms for free clothing and child care services over a period of several months

30 adults and 22 children successfully housed
80% of students were placed in jobs or enrolled in college

72% of these youth retained employment or remained enrolled in school

88% of the youth attained a GED/HSD, PACT, or CNA Certificate

78.46% of students demonstrated an increase in literacy and numeracy levels
